Effective July 1, 2008 the Elevator and Amusement Device Bureau will start inspecting zip lines. If you find these devices in your area, please contact your supervisor and the Raleigh Office. Do not issue a shut down order. Due to the fact that this is a new requirement, we are going to work with the owners of these devices to bring them into compliance.

The fee for these devices will be the same as a major ride: \$90. Please instruct the owners of such devices as to what documentation we will be requiring; MFG manuals if industry produced or P.E certification if home made.
