NORTH CAROLINA STATE AGENCY WORKPLACE REQUIREMENT PROGRAM FOR SAFETY & HEALTH

**Article 63 of Chapter 143 & Chapter 126-4(10) of NCGS
NCGS 97-12 of the NC Workers Compensation Act
NCGS 95-148, 143-580 – 143-584
NCAC: 25 NCAC 1N.0105(a)**

The statutes referenced above require each North Carolina State agency to establish a written program for State employee workplace safety and health. There are specific program requirements including workplace safety inspections, goals, training, committee activity, and so forth.
